

BASEL-STADT

This file contains election results for the Basel-Stadt Grosser Rat in 2000, 2004, 2008 and 2012.

Votes totals are presented in unweighted and weighted (*Chiffre de pondération/Wählerzahl*) form. Voters may cast as many votes for candidates as there are mandates in the constituency, and voters are permitted to vote for candidates of different parties (*panachage*). The number of mandates per constituency varies, so weighting is necessary to render the results comparable across constituencies. The votes presented here are weighted by the valid votes cast in the constituency. Weighted totals are unavailable for 2000 as the valid votes are unavailable for that year.
