

CURAÇAO

This file contains election results for the Curaçao Staten (Estates) in 2012 and the Curaçao Eilandsraad (Island Council) in 2003, 2007, and 2010 by polling place. When Curaçao became a separate country within the Kingdom of the Netherlands upon dissolution of the Netherlands Antilles on 10 October 2010, the Curaçao Island Council became the Curaçao Staten. The Curaçao Staten should not be confused with the Netherlands Antilles Staten, which served as the parliament of the entire Netherlands Antilles (Curaçao, Bonaire, Sint Maarten, Saba, and Sint Eustatius).
